## NEPA's Subdivision Applications Process



NEPA receives application along with site inspection report & recommendation from the Local Planning Authority (Parish Council).



NEPA assesses application for completeness and circulates application to the relevant Agencies.

NEPA Technical Branch processes application, including research & conducting site visits, if necessary.

If application is 10 lots and over and 5 acres and more. If application is 9 lots and under and less than 5 acres.



NEPA and relevant Agencies review application at Subdivision Committee Meeting and make recommendations. NEPA prepares and dispatches recommendations to the Local Planning Authority (Parish Council).

NEPA returns incomplete application to Local Planning Authority.

For subdivision applications 10 lots & more, NEPA informs applicant that a permit is required.
