- Justice of the Peace, giving the applicant permission to use the land for the proposed activity, must be submitted along with a copy of the title and a copy of the Identification for both parties, e.g. current Driver's Licence, National ID or Passport.
- If the registered title is held jointly, either all parties must be reflected as the applicant <u>or</u> there should be a letter or authorization from the other title holder (s) giving the applicant permission to use the land for the proposed activity. The letter or authorization must be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace

and must be accompanied by a copy of the Identification for each of the I parties, e.g. current Driver's Licence, National ID or Passport.

- ALL CONTRACTORS/AGENTS/CONSULTANTS who are applying for Permits and Licences on behalf of someone else, must submit a letter (with each application), giving them authority to apply for the Permit/Licence. The letter must also state the extent of their authority in relation to the application and in whose name the Permit/License should be issued. The letter must be signed by all the relevant parties who they represent and witnessed by a Justice of the Peace, and must be presented along with a copy of the Identification for each of the parties e.g. current Driver's Licence, National ID or Passport.
