



PUBLIC NOTICE

RENEWAL OF BEACH LICENCES

Pursuant to Regulation 5(i) of the **Beach Control (Licensing)**Regulation, Beach Licences expire on 31 March of each year.

As such, payments to renew said licences for the period of 2017 to 2018 must be made to the National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA) on or before the aforementioned date or as set out in the Beach Licence(s).

TAKE FURTHER NOTE that it is a criminal offence to encroach on or use the foreshore or floor of the sea for any public purpose, in connection with any trade, business or commercial enterprise without a beach licence and the renewal thereof.

The Agency will proceed to publicly name **all** parties that fail to renew their licences while continuing to operate in breach of the Beach Control Act. All measures available in law to ensure compliance will be exercised.
