The National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA) announces the start of the 2014 Game Bird Hunting Season which opens, Saturday, August 16 and closes on Sunday, September 21, 2014.

During the Season, hunting sessions are: from sunrise to 9:00 A.M. & 2:30 P.M. to sunset on Saturdays and from sunrise to 9:00 A.M. on Sundays. Hunting outside these prescribed times is an offence punishable under the law.

Only the following birds may be hunted: Zenaida Dove/Pea Dove (Zenaida aurita), White-winged Dove (Zenaida asiatica), White Crown Pigeon/Bald-pate (Patagioenas leucocephala) and Mourning Dove/Long-tailed Pea Dove (Zenaida macroura).

Hunter's Licence may be obtained from NEPA and authorized vendors. The fee for the Hunter's Licence is \$15,000. All hunters must have a valid Firearm's Licence or user's permit.

Under the Wild Life Protection Act and the Hunters' Licences Regulations, all hunters must have a valid Hunter's Licence in order to hunt birds during the Game Bird Hunting Season. A breach will attract a fine of up to one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) and or imprisonment.

Under the Wild Life Protection (Hunter's Licences) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008, hunters who fail to submit their Hunters' Bird Shooting Report Form will not be eligible for a Hunter's Licence for the 2014 Game Bird Hunting Season until the Report is submitted and the late processing fee of \$5000 has been paid at NEPA.

Members of the public and bird hunters are, hereby, advised that the Wild Life (Declaration of Shooting Season) Order, 2014 is in force between **16 August - 21 September 2014**.
