## Re: Request for Data - Port Esquivel Environs

Please find attached data pertaining to the Port Esquivel environs as captioned. The information includes data that was available in the WRA's database at the time of compilation. Please take note of the following:

- 1. Rainfall data within the vicinity of the project site was available for the Longswharf rainfall station
- 2. The WRA does not have evapotranspiration data in the vicinity of the site
- 3. The WRA does not maintain a stream discharge monitoring point within the vicinity of the site hence we do not have discharge for those streams within the vicinity of the site.
- 4. The WRA is not aware of any incidents of flooding within the vicinity of the site
- 5. The WRA does not currently possess floodplain maps of the site or within the vicinity of the site
- 6. The WRA does not currently have a groundwater vulnerability map of the area.
- 7. There are no groundwater abstraction points at the site that are within the WRA's database within 1 kilometer of the site.

Please note that the efforts to compile the data have attracted a service charge of \$3,490. See invoice for details.
