

Air Quality Management

Did you know that NEPA is the principal institution with responsibility for ambient (outdoor) air quality management and has implemented a **National** Air Quality Management Programme? The country's air quality is monitored via several monitoring sites across the island.

Policies and standards have been implemented and promulgated to control air pollution from major and significant facilities. These include: the Natural Resources Conservation Authority (NRCA) Air Quality Regulations, (2006); the Natural Resources Conservation Authority Ambient Air Quality Guidelines, Natural Resources Conservation Authority Air Quality Standards 1996; the Natural Resources Conservation Authority Stack Emission Targets for existing sources and Natural Resources Conservation Authority Stack Emission Standards for New Sources.

The Agency has also instituted a Register of Air Quality Licensees which is accessible to the public via our website and facilitates the Visual Emission Observer training of individuals in both the private and public sector.
